

Adobe Digital Editions & Adobe ID

Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) allows users to download and read EPUB and PDF formatted eBooks on a computer or transfer to an eReader device via a USB cable. Many eBook services provide an eReader within their apps, so ADE may not be necessary.

An Adobe ID is required to use ADE and, in some cases, to use an eBook service's app.

Adobe Digital Editions

These instructions apply to all users prompted to install Adobe Digital Editions or to supply an Adobe ID. This should be paired with the specific service and platform instructions.

1. To register for an Adobe ID, visit <http://www.adobe.com> and click Sign In in the upper right.
2. Click Get an Adobe ID and provide the requested information. Make note of the email address and password.
3. When asked by an eBook app or service to **Authorize This Device** (language may vary by service), enter your Adobe ID information. This is the email address and password you supplied in step 2.
 - This step may need to be performed on each device that you intend to use. In each case, you will be prompted to supply the registration information.

If you are using an eBook service's app, the Adobe ID may be all that is required. If you are prompted to install Adobe Digital Editions (usually on a PC or Mac computer), proceed with the instructions below.

1. Download and install the appropriate Adobe Digital Editions version from <http://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions/download.html>.
 - **Note:** We recommend always using the latest version of ADE.
2. Open an EPUB or PDF formatted eBook by double-clicking the cover image (may vary by service and platform). Use the scroll bar and arrows on the bottom of the screen to turn pages. Other functionality, including font sizing, bookmarking and text searching is available at the top of the screen.
